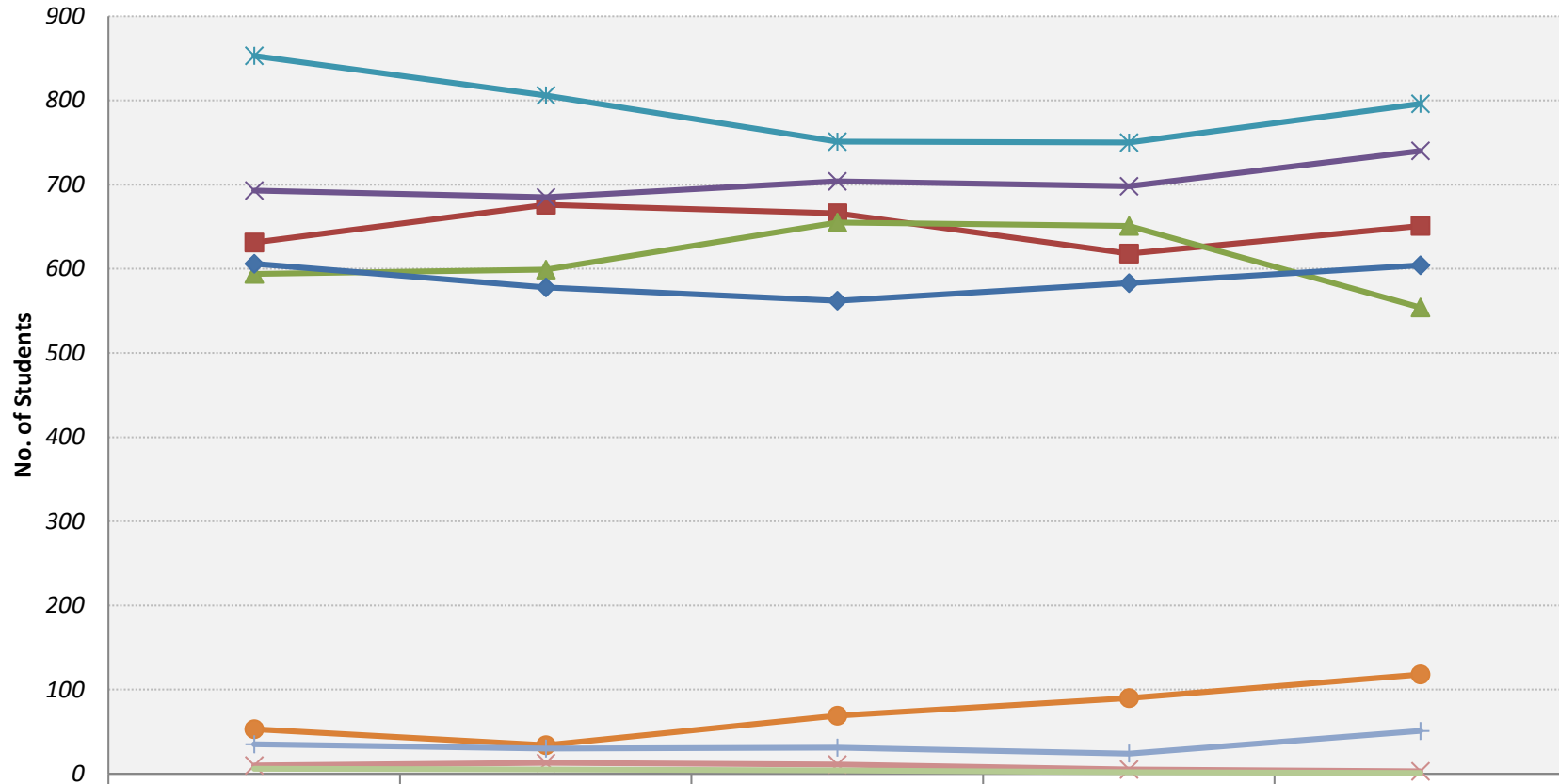

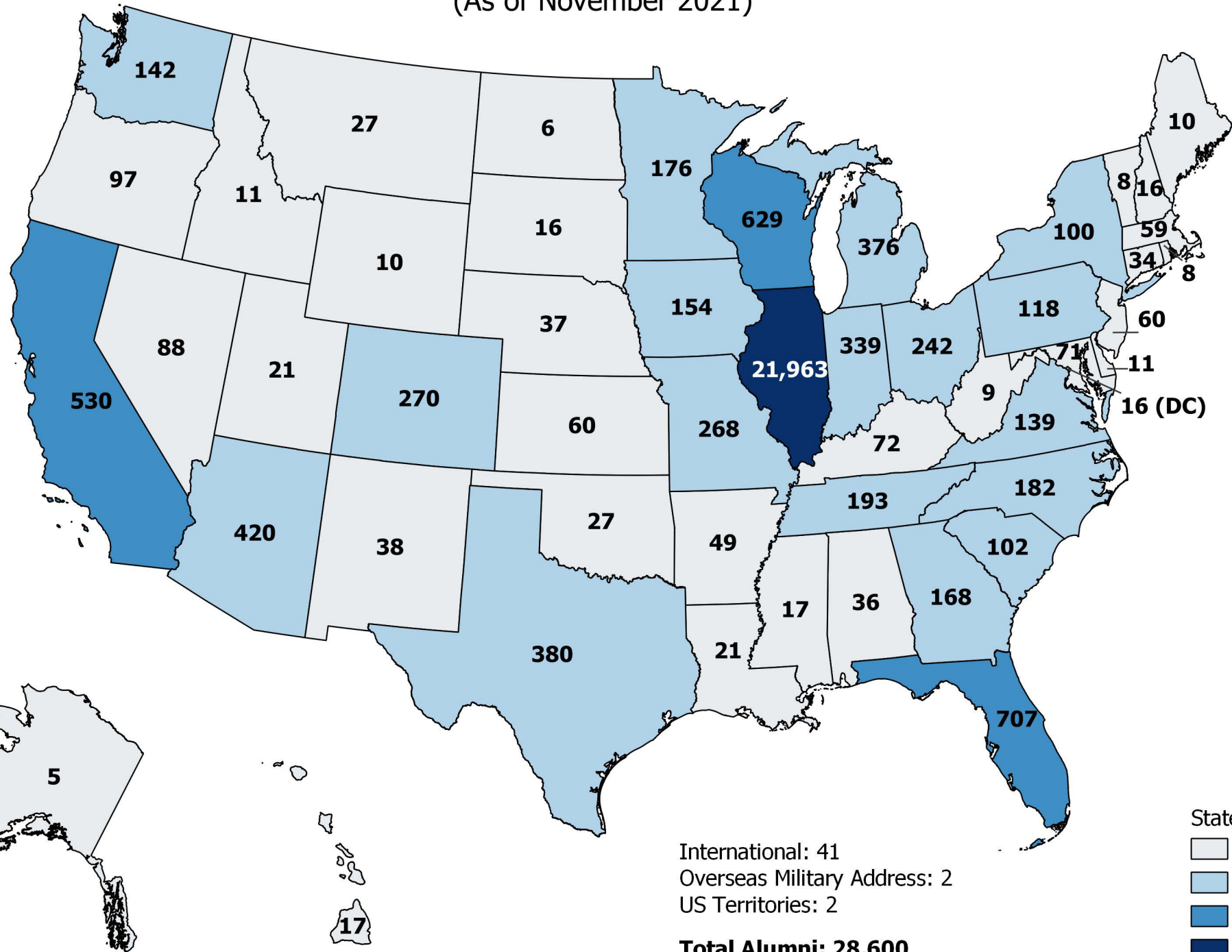

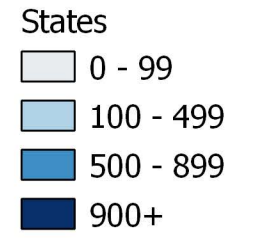
Undergraduate Alumni by State of Residence
